
Green Lecture Hall ("Zelená posluchárna")

The venue of the 7th Ptolemaic Summer School will be the **Green Lecture Hall** ("Zelená posluchárna") in **Celetná** street. Enter through the main gate at Celetná 20 (photo on left) and proceed towards the elevator and staircase on the left side at the end of the entrance hall. On the first floor, please follow the signs for the lecture hall.

The nearest metro stations to the venue are **Staroměstská** on the green metro line, **Můstek** on

the green and yellow lines, Náměstí republiky on the yellow line and Museum on the red line.

GENERAL VISITOR INFORMATION

1. TRANSPORT IN PRAGUE

Travelling by public transport is only possible with a valid ticket, which has to be obtained before boarding the vehicle or entering the metro system. The ticket is valid only if marked in the validation appliance.

Tickets can be bought at most metro stations (look for the yellow/orange slot machines) or in *Dopravni Podnik* Information Centres, at hotels, news stands, tobacconists etc. One can also buy tickets for the Prague integrated transport (PID) in the mobile app "PID Lítačka", which is available for download in the Google/Apple Store. You pay for the ticket via credit/debit card. Before using the ticket, you need to activate it in the application. The validity of the ticket starts two minutes after the validation.

- Basic ticket 32 CZK (one Euro presently equals about 25.50 Czech crowns). This ticket is valid for 90 minutes from the moment of validation.
- Short term ticket 24 CZK. Tickets are valid for 30 minutes from the moment of validation.
- Luggage 16 CZK (if the dimensions exceed 25x45x70 cm).
- 24-hour ticket 110 CZK
- 3-day ticket 310 CZK

The metro system operates every day between 4.45 a.m. and midnight. Most trams and buses operate every day between 4.30 a.m. and midnight. The frequency of public transport during the day depends on the time of day. Night trams and buses cover the period between midnight and 4.30 a.m.
